2 SNACK

Each family is responsible for providing a snack for their own child. In your child's snack bag, please provide a spill proof water bottle filled with water and a small healthy snack. Your child should be able to open and close his/her own water bottle independently.

We encourage and discuss nutritious, healthy snacks to help promote healthy bodies. Students are encouraged to open packages and containers during snack time and sharing of snacks is not allowed due to allergies and germs. Discuss healthy snacks at home and have your child help pack his/her snack. It's best to avoid sending cookies, or food items that have a large amount of added sugar or items such as chips.

During snack time we look at students snack and discuss all of the healthy foods. This encourages students to have and eat their healthy snacks... great awareness!

Snack ideas: Fruits, veggies, crackers & cheese, yogurt, sausage, whole grain muffins, etc.



3 ABSENCE


To report your child's absence, please log in to the Parent PowerSchool Portal and enter their absence directly; use each tab for your children to report each respective child that will be absent from school. *Attendance must be entered prior to 8:00 am for the morning and by 11:30 am for the afternoon to avoid an Unexcused Absence call from the school. It is helpful to also email/notify the classroom teacher of your child's absence if you know in advance.

5 DROP OFF

Your cooperation in bringing your child to school and picking up on time is greatly appreciated. All adults and children, who do not take the bus, wait outside the front of the school prior to classes commencing until a teacher/staff member greets students and leads them to the classroom. Please say good-bye to your child outside of the school as they need to gain independence and be able to get ready for class time on their own. Although this may be a difficult transition for you and your child at first, this will only help your child adjust quickly to coming to school and developing these skills.



6 PICK UP



Students will be dismissed from the front of the school. Adults who are picking up a child are asked to wait outside at the front of the school until your child is dismissed directly to you. Students will be released one by one and are asked to wait until a staff member dismisses them. Please notify the classroom teacher or the school office if you have made alternate arrangements for someone else to pick up your child.

During the year we will have visitors from Edmonton Catholic School's Multidisciplinary team come to our Kindergarten class. This may include the following specialists: Speech and Language Pathologist/assistant, Occupational Therapist/assistant, Behaviour Specialist/assistant, and Consultant. We look forward to having them share their expertise with our class community.



One of the goals of Kindergarten is for children to develop personal independence. You can help by sending your child to school with clothing, shoes, and food containers that they can manage by themselves. At home, please work with your child to zip coats, do up buttons/snaps and tie shoe laces. It takes a long time to develop these skills and lots of practice and patience!



You will receive some reminders via email but otherwise, please get in the habit of checking the <u>classroom website</u> for dates and information. These are located under the Student Life section of the St. John Bosco school website. Please ensure that all forms and notes are returned in a timely manner.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Refer to the <u>school website</u> for a complete supply list. Please label belongings with child's name.

- One pair of indoor running shoes that your child can put on independently. It is strongly recommend velcro shoes with grip for physical education and non-scuff.
- Backpack (Large enough to hold a snack bag, water bottle, library book, agenda, extra set of clothes, etc.
- Snack bag and Spill proof water bottle (Your child should be able to open and close his/her water bottle independently)
- Extra set of clothing for your child (Socks, underwear, shirt, and pants) in case of an accident or getting wet or dirty during exploration. Place these clothes in a labeled, large ziplock bag. These clothes will be kept in your child's backpackand brought to and from school daily.

11 PATHS KID OF THE DAY

The PATHS kid of the day program is a way of getting to know every student a little better and giving them an opportunity to speak in front of the class. When it is your child's turn to be PATHS kid of the Day, he/she is the classroom helper for the day. Your child will lead the classroom meeting and be the line leader for the day. This gives them an opportunity to develop their self-confidence and oral language skills.

12) THURSDAY/FRIDAY SWITCH

Throughout the school year the district switches the Thursday early dismissal days to the following Friday. Although Kindergarten does not have school on Thursdays, we are still required to switch these days as well. During these switches, Kindergarten will have class on Thursday but not on Friday.

March 21, 2025




14) FIRE DRILLS & LOCKDOWN



We will be discussing fire drills and lockdown procedures throughout the school year. There may be practice drills beginning September. A lockdown practice can sometimes be frightening for a child. The example of a "bad dog" getting into the school instead of a "bad person" or other problem examples will be used. Talk to your child about what a practice drill means.

15) SCHOOL COUNCIL

A good way to get involved at St. John Bosco Catholic School is though the School Council. The School Council is the liaison between the parents and the school. The committee involves volunteering parents and the teachers who work together to provide an enriched and effective program. There are meetings held about once a month to share ideas.











Children may borrow one book at a time for up to a week. Please help your child establish routines to take good care of borrowed books.





- 2. Use clean hands when viewing books

We value the importance of daily physical activity and will be implemented throughout each day. It may take place in the classroom, the gym, the playground or outside in the field.

We ask that when your child is not well, that you keep them at home so they can rest and give their body time to deal with symptoms. Any students who are manifesting signs and symptoms of being unwell at school will be sent to the office and their parents called for pickup.



We will be discussing colours throughout the school year. On the classroom website calendar, there are days that are marked with a coloured circle. Please have your child wear something that corresponds to the colour for that day. If your child does not have any clothing or items to wear that match the colour, please do not go and buy items. You can place a coloured sticker on your child's shirt or he/she will get a stamp/dot of that colour. We will be discussing the chosen colour for two days and becoming "colour detectives." Allow your child the opportunity to help find objects at home that has the corresponding colour.

20) PARKING

Please do not park in front of the school in the designated daycare/bus zones, in the layby, or in the staff parking lot. There is a designed handicap parking which you may use if you have a valid handicap placard. You may park on the opposite side of the school, on the street. Please be mindful not to use community residents driveways. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated as this area may get quite congested as there are other classes arriving or being dismissed at the same time. Keeping this area clear will help ensure the safety of the students during drop off and dismissal. If you are parked across the street, please walk to the marked crosswalks. No jaywalking! Remember that your child will model the steps that you take.
